How the U.S. Government Is Organized The Constitution of the United States divides the federal government into three branches to make sure no individual or group will have too much power:

Legislative—Makes laws (Congress, comprised of the House of Representatives and Senate)

The U.S. Constitution establishes a government based on "federalism." This is the sharing of power between the national and state (as well as local) governments. This power-sharing form of government

is the opposite of "centralized" governments, under which a national government maintains total power.

The Basic Structure of the U.S. Federal Government
The President of the United States is the elected leader of the country. As the head of state, the president is the leader of the federal government, and Commander in Chief of the United States Armed Forces. Elected according to the Electoral College process, the president serves a four-year term and is limited to serving no more than two terms.
